The meeting regarding CRZ clearance for construction of the "All Weather Helipad" (3nos.) with adjacent VIP rest room at Sagar Island under Diamond Harbour Highway division was held on 23rd December, 2019 at Conference Hall of Department of Environment, Government of West Bengal, Pranisampad Bhaban, 5th floor, LB-2, Sector-III, Salt Lake, Kokkata-700106. Shri Prabhat Kumar Mishra, IAS, Principal Secretary, Department of Environment, Government of West Bengal chaired the meeting. The list of participants is annexed herewith.

- 2. PWD will provide revised layout of the project site to IESWM within 2 days.
- 3. IESWM will prepared the revised Maps within 10 days of the receiving of revised layout of the project area.
- 4.Replies to the checklist for dock/ jetty/ processing plant/ storage will be submitted in consultation with the expert member.
