I. CONSIDERATION/RECONSIDERATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE

In view of O.M. F No. 21-103/2015-IA.III dated 02.11.2018 issued by MoEF&CC, the WBPCB shall not issue Consent to Operate till the PP obtains permission for drawl of ground water from SWID.

The application for EC is approved based on the HMC Building Permit No. 391/19-20 dated 06.03.2021.

INTRODUCTION

The proponent made online application vide proposal no. SIA/WB/MIS/183102/2020 dated 28.11.2020 seeking environment clearance under the provisions of the EIA Notification, 2006 for the above-mentioned project. The proposed project activity is listed at SL. No. 8(a) Building and Construction projects under Category "B2" of EIA Notification 2006.

The project was placed in the 54th meeting of SEIAA held on 29.03.2022 and observed the following :-

a) Mohiary No. 2 Gram Panchayat mentioned vide their letter no. nil dated 12.09.2019 that they would not be able to provide water supply to the project and necessary permission to be obtained for extraction of ground water.

The proposed project is a large scale high density project with a built up area of 39558.65 sqm. and a total footfall of 9532 (Fixed – 1594, Floating – 7922, Service – 16) persons. The provision for water supply as well as other services needs to be addressed by the local body while approving the building sanction plan.

Continuous extraction of ground water for a long period results in depletion of the ground aquifer. This is a serious environmental hazard inviting subsidence and contamination of arsenic etc. For the said project application for EC, SEIAA prefers not to allow extraction of ground water during operational phase of the project. The local body need to ensure supply of piped water supply mentioning a feasible time frame in this regard. In case the piped water supply is not made available within a period of 5 (five) years, the EC would liable to be cancelled. The PP was requested to take up the matter to local body or any other competent authority and address the issues.

The project proponent uploaded documents on 20.04.2022.

DELIBERATION IN SEIAA

SEIAA considered the submission made by the project proponent (PP) vide their letter submitted on 20.04.2022 and accepted the same.

RECOMMENDATIONS OF SEIAA

The application for EC is approved based on the Building Permit No. 95/032/HZP/PS dated 07.10.2020 issued by Howrah Zilla Parishad.

CONCLUSION

Out of 163 pending applications, 160 applications were submitted within 31.03.2022 and 3 applications were submitted after 31.03.2022. In view of Order No. 90-ICE/0/MIN/GEN-MIS/27/2021 dated 17.02.2022 issued by the Dept. of Industry, Commerce & Enterprises, Mines Branch, GoWB, the project proponents (PPs) who have applied within 31.03.2022 will have the option of relisting their application with appropriate and complete documents including approved DSR as per the existing provisions in the PARIVESH portal.

It is further decided to delist all the pending 195 ToR applications for mining of minor minerals in view of the reasons stated in para above.

(B) Complaint received from Ankur Sharma about desperate fraud upon authorities of the state in respect of property at KMC Holding no. 47, Matheswartola Road, Ward No. 66, Borough – VII, Kolkata – 700046.

An EC was issued for the project based on KMC Mutation Certificate and sanction plan along with Building permit. MS, SEIAA may write to KMC to assess the veracity of the complaint.

 Meeting under the Chairmanship of the Secretary, MoEF&CC held on 29.04.2022 at 11:00 a.m. through VC to review issues related to EC with States / UTs.

The meeting started at 11:00 a.m. convened by Secretary, MoEF&CC. Chairman and Member Secretary from a majority of the states participated and deliberated in the meeting. The deliberations by the SEIAAs were made alphabetically based on the names of the states. A presentation was given by MoEF&CC mentioning new features in the PARIVESH portal and reforms made therein. PARIVESH-2 was also announced to be launched soon.

Chairman, SEIAA, WB highlighted the following issues:-

i. The pendency of EC cases reflected in the portal are mainly due to sand mining cases, which could not be appraised nor processed due to incomplete applications. In none of the cases of sand mining applications, the approved DSRs are available.

The rest of the pendency is negligible and would be cleared soon. SEIAA, WB is also aiming for a zero pendency.

ii. EC applications for stone crushing units could not be processed under the mining category in which the project proponent have applied. There is no provision for dealing / processing of EC applications under any other category in the portal.

NGT, Principle Bench in O.A No. 475/2016 dated 19.07.2017 and subsequent order in M.A. No. 13/2019 dated 31.01.2019 have directed that 'no stone crushers can be permitted to operate unless they obtain consent from the State PCB, proper NOC from concerned authorities and have Environment Clearance from the competent authority'.

Since stone crushing unit is not listed in any schedule of EIA Notification, 2006 (as amended) nor reflected in the portal, MoEF&CC was requested to include the same in the EIA Notification, 2006 as well as in the portal in order to comply with the directives of the Hon'ble NGT. The MoEF&CC agreed to include the same.

- iii. It was pointed out that there is no provision for cancellation / revocation of EC in the portal. In cases where the project proponent fails to comply with the EC conditions or violates EC conditions, the EC deserves to be cancelled / revoked. The MoEF&CC agreed to include and make such provisions in the portal.
- iv. It was mentioned that there is no infrastructure, office, support staffs for functioning of SEIAA, WB. This issue had been already raised with the MoEF&CC for their intervention in the matter, however, the same has not yet been resolved. In the absence of basic infrastructure and office, it is becoming extremely difficult for SEIAA, WB functioning.
- Disposal of EC applications for mining of minor minerals.

Partie and Party

Based on the deliberation made by the Chairman, SEIAA, WB, MoEF&CC opined that all EC applications for mining of minor minerals without DSR and other mandatory documents are required to be delisted. Thus, SEIAA decided to delist all pending 163 EC applications for mining of minor minerals. Out of 163 pending applications, 160 applications were submitted within 31.03.2022 and 3 applications were submitted after 31.03.2022. In view of Order No. 90-ICE/0/MIN/GEN-MIS/27/2021 dated 17.02.2022 issued by the Dept. of Industry, Commerce & Enterprises, Mines Branch, GoWB, the project proponents (PPs) who have applied within 31.03.2022 will have the option of relisting their application with appropriate and complete documents including approved DSR as per the existing provisions in the PARIVESH portal.

Dealing with High Court cases for disposal of EC applications for sand mining.

Based on the Order of Hon'ble Calcutta High Court in sand mining cases, Chief Environment Officer & Member Secretary, SEIAA is conducting hearing of the PP to dispose off the cases. MS, SEIAA is requested to place the list of such cases before SEIAA for ratification.

 Hon'ble NGT O. A. No. 42/2022/EZ - Prabir Kr. Bose Vs State of West Bengal.

In view of the order of the NGT, Eastern Zone Bench, Kolkata in the case referred above, Prof. Indranath Sinha, Member, SEAC is nominated to represent SEIAA, WB in the committee.

5. Discussion on online status of pending EC/ToR applications.

Based on the deliberation made by MoEF&CC and observing the present status of pendency of EC applications reflected in the PARIVESH Portal as on date, SEIAA, WB intend to take the following actions:-
