MINUTES OF THE 46TH MEETING OF STATE LEVEL ENVIRONMENT IMPACT ASSESSMENT AUTHORITY (SEIAA) HELD ON 22ND JANUARY, 2019 AT PRANI SAMPAD BHAVAN

The forty-sixth meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) was held on 22nd January, 2019 in the Conference Room of Environment Department, Prani Sampad Bhavan, 5th Floor, LB - Block, Sector – III, Salt Lake, Kol-106. Following cases were discussed:

I. Cases for Final Environmental Clearance

1. Application for Environmental Clearance for the proposed Manipur Clay Mines at Plot No. 36, 37, 38, 481(P), 482(P), 483, 484(P), 492(P), J.L. No: 01, Mouza – Manipur, P.S. – Taldangra, Dist. Bankura, West Bengal by Sri Nepal Chandra Das. (SIA/WB/MIN/60810/2016)

The Authority considered the recommendation of SEAC and approved the proposal for Environmental Clearance for a period of 7 (seven) years subject to the grant of Mining Lease and validity of the Mining Scheme, whichever is earlier.

2. Application for Environmental Clearance for the proposed acid slurry (LABSA) manufacturing unit for the production of 275 MT acid slurry and 225 MT spent sulfuric acid per month at, J.L. No.60, L.R. Khatian No. 637, L.R. Plot No.: 1410, Vill: Bhaturia, P.O.:Barunanpara, P.S.: Polba, Dist: Hooghly, Pin: 712148, West Bengal by M/s. Sandhya Chemicals. (SIA/WB/IND2/82368/2018)

The Authority considered the recommendation of SEAC and approved the proposal for Environmental Clearance.

II. Violation cases

1. Application for Environmental for the expansion of the proposed residential complex 'ALTIUS' at 67, Christopher Road, Kolkata 700 046, West Bengal by M/s Harmony Vinimay Pvt. Ltd. (SIA/WB/NCP/29734/2018)

The matter was discussed and SEIAA decided to forward the appeal to SEAC for appraisal of the fresh remediation plan.

III. Miscellaneous

1. Corrigendum in the Environmental Clearance No. 3310/EN/T-II-1/045/2017 dated 03.10.2018 issued to M/s. Bansal Cement Private Limited.

SEIAA considered the letter vide No. Bansal_Cement/SEIAA/18-19/01 dated 04.01.2019 from the project proponent and decided to correct the stack height for cement grinding unit from 60 meters to 35 meters.
