## MINUTES OF THE 33<sup>RD</sup> MEETING OF STATE LEVEL ENVIRONMENT IMPACT ASSESSMENT AUTHORITY (SEIAA) HELD ON 27<sup>TH</sup> JUNE, 2018 AT ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT

The thirty third meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) was held on 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 in the Conference Room of Environment Department, Prani Sampad Bhavan, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, LB - Block, Sector - III, Salt Lake, Kol-106. Following cases were discussed:

## I. Cases for Final Environmental Clearance

 Application for Environmental Clearance for the proposed expansion of housing complex at Mouza -Doulatpur, Block - Bishnupur1, J.L. No. 79, Diamond Harbour Road, P.O. Joka, P.S. - Bishnupur under Kulerdari Gram Panchayet, Dist. South 24 Parganas, West Bengal by M/s. DTC Projects Pvt. Ltd.

The Authority considered the recommendation of SEAC and approved the proposal for Environmental Clearance in supersession of earlier EC vide No. 728 /EN/T-II-1/010/2015 dated 29/03/2016.

 Application for Environmental Clearance for the proposed expansion of residential complex at Mouza - Sripur, Bagherghol, "A"; 272, Boral Main Road, P.S. Sonarpur, Dist. South 24 Parganas, Ward No. 33 of Rajpur -Sonarpur Municipality, Pin - 700 103, West Bengal by M/s. Prudent Infrarealty Pvt. Ltd

The Authority considered the recommendation of SEAC and approved the proposal for Environmental Clearance.

4. Letter from Project Proponent - Environmental clearance application for the proposed expansion of Stadium 'Gitanjali' and commercial complex 'Acropolis' at 1858, Rajdanga Main Road, KMC Ward No. 107, P.O. EKTP, PS -Kasba, Kolkata - 700 107, West Bengal by M/s. Merlin Projects Ltd.

In continuation with the decision made in the 22nd meeting of SEIAA held on 21.11.2017 a site visit was made by some of the members of SEAC and SEIAA in presence of the project proponent on 01.02.2018. Some options were discussed regarding the alternative positions of STP and the project proponent was requested to explore the possibilities. Thereafter they have come up with the proposal vide letter no. nil dated 05.06.2018. SEAC is requested to appraise on the same.
